

FRSAD Report Errata

The following errors were found in the FRSAD Final Report.[1]

Chapter 5, Section 5.4.2 currently reads:

5.4.2 The Whole-Part Relationship

The *whole-part relationship* also exists between *nomens*. A *nomen* may have components (parts). These components may or may not be a *nomen* on their own. The composition of such *nomen* may be governed by rules, for example, the citation order in faceted classification schemes or the order of subdivisions in a subject heading.

It should read:

5.4.2 The Whole-Part Relationship

A *nomen* may have components (parts). The composition of such a *nomen* may be governed by rules, for example, the citation order in a faceted classification scheme or the order of subdivisions in a subject heading system. The components may be *nomens* on their own. In such cases this is a *whole-part relationship* between *nomens*.
